GACO and Guernsey Cricket hosted a two day Workshop for umpires and scorers from the Channel Islands and Europe. Attendees came from Jersey, Germany, Portugal, Denmark as well as current and new participants from Guernsey.

The Workshop was run by David Jukes and Ian Gould along with Gina Kearns who ran the Scorers course.

David is well known as a match referee appointed by the ICC to the ICC Panel of International Match Referees to officiate Women's Tests and Men's and Women's ODIs and T20I plus Pathway Events and U19 World Cups. Ian joined the First Class umpires panel in 2002, was promoted to the international panel in April 2006 and the ICC Elite Panel of Umpires three years later. He is now and ECB Umpire Coach.



The Workshop covered the respective roles of the officials groups at ICC Pathway tournaments and the inter-action between each, recent rules changes, discussion on controversial incidents from recent international matches, player management and working as a team on the field.

It is hoped that the event will become an annual event.
